The Institution / College is fully responsible to fulfil the norms and to maintain the same which includes infrastructure both physical and human resource, teaching faculty and clinical material, etc., throughout the academic year, as stipulated in regulations of Medical Council of India.

The number of students admitted shall not exceed the number of students permitted for annual admissions both under University and Management Quota as specified by the Medical Council of India / KNRUHS.

The Management of the College shall follow the regulations made by the University/State Government and also the Graduate Medical Education Regulations 1997 of the Medical Council of India in making admissions, in conducting examinations and in respect of all other related matters from time to time.
